I must emphasize that every one of these blockade actions is being led by the Worcester Anti-Foreclosure Team – because these cases are extremely intricate and complicated, each one like a separate and unique legal chess game, and the WAFT people are like legal geniuses – but I will mention that every demonstrator there today was wearing “Occupy” participant insignia of one kind or another.

Even folks who have not otherwise participated in our movement happily accepted “Occupy Worcester” stickers I had made and was handing out and pasted them on their coats. I think it's okay that I felt proud.

Well, after that I went to Coney Island on Southbridge Street and had three hot dogs with chili, cheese and onions.
